Arts, Culture and Sports

Distinctive achievement in expression and development of the visual, literary or performing arts or sports.

Business, Professional and Entrepreneur

Distinctive achievement in innovation, management, administration, in a profession or trade, in the business sector, or in non-profit organizations.

Communications and Media

For distinctive achievement in the development and production of using public media to tell a God-honouring message. The recipient will have exhibited excellence and integrity in using some form of film, video, television, print, radio, internet or other communication and media methodology.

Education, Training and Development

Distinctive achievement in formal or informal education, employee training and development and/ or research in leadership and personal and professional development.

Ministry

Distinctive achievement in church, denominational and ministry organizations, or mission leadership.

Public Service

Distinctive achievement in community development, environmental issues, politics, or other public service initiatives.

Science and Technology

Distinctive achievement through research or application in science or technology, including the health and wellness industry.

Young Leader

Distinctive achievement for leaders 30 years of age and under in ministry, community, or mission leadership.

- Participating in a range of activities
- Visionary leadership
- Networking and connecting people so they can excel
